Biographical Note

Born in Mortagne-au-Perche, France 1844, died in 1914; publicist and Blanquist militant; imprisoned for six months after a Blanquist demonstration in 1866; belonged to one of the first Blanquist battle groups; actively participated in the Paris Commune; after the collapse fled to England; member of the London Blanquist group La Commune révolutionnaire; returned to Paris in 1880; founded the Comité Révolutionnaire Central (CRC) in 1881; Member of Parliament in 1889; left politics in 1893; contributor to the CRC organs, and to La Patrie en Danger, Le Cri du Peuple and L'Intransigeant.

Vaughan, César de Paepe, Auguste Blanqui, Edouard Vaillant and others; letters and documents from and concerning La Société des Réfugiés de la Commune de Paris à Londres, L'Assemblée Générale des Réfugiés de la Commune à Genève, Comité de Secours des Réfugiés à Jersey, La Société des Réfugiés de la Commune à New York, etc.; documents concerning Blanqui; police records from the Paris Commune; reports; press clippings.
